It took its full effect from 24th October 1945, along with the formation of the United Nations. Today the UN is the largest, most familiar, most internationally represented and most powerful intergovernmental organization in the world. Its main objective lies in maintaining the International Order along with Harmony and cooperation between the Nations. Headquartered at New York, the United Nation at the onset had 51 member countries which raised to 193 presently.
